Jim Bowie #1

I was born in Georgia in 1799 and was always big for my age. During the first 29 years of my life I moved around a lot but finally settled in Texas in 1828.

I was born in Texas in 1799, but left Texas to settle for a spell in Alabama and Mississippi. I lived a rough life, pirating with Jean Lafitte and fighting Indians. I was even shot once in a gun fight.

Jim Bowie #3

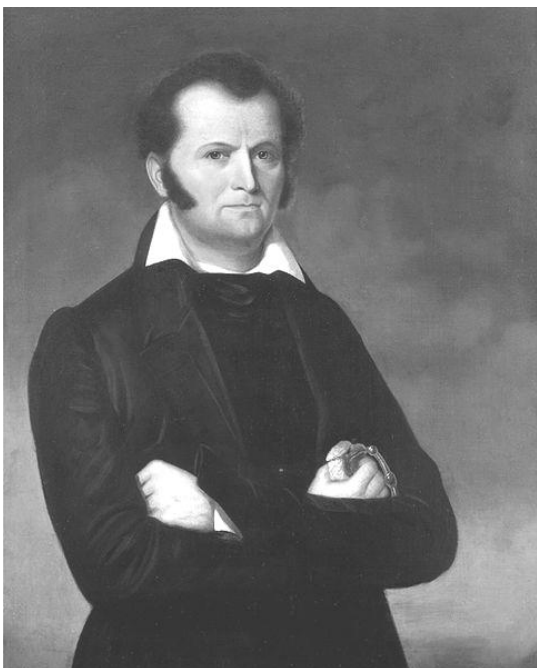
I was a prospector and a land speculator hoping to make my fortune in Texas lands. I never fought Indians but I did fight in the Texas resistance movement.
