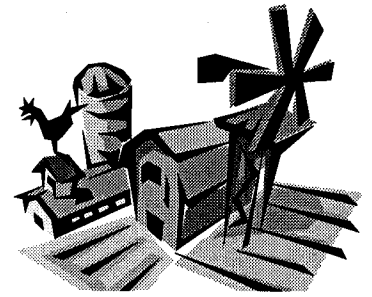


Meadowlark Farm
