

WARM-UP ACTIVITY FAMOUS PAIRS

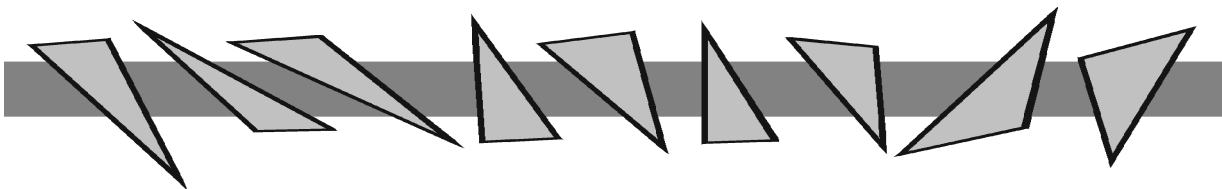
Number of Players: Up to thirty-four

Objective: To match famous twosomes in literature.

Procedure: Cut apart the pairs. Give one name to each player. Each player must try to find the player who has the name to make the matching pair.

Ask students who have matched a pair to present a dialogue for the class without mentioning names. The class can guess the names of the famous pair.
