

WHAT KIND OF SMART? QUESTIONNAIRE *

DIRECTIONS: Read through all the categories (**WS**, **L/NS**, etc.), mentally answering the questions. Note which ones you have more 'yes' answers for. Try to identify your top two categories.

___ **WS**—Do you like to read? Are word puzzles a challenge? Do you enjoy working with words? Do you like to write?

___ **L/NS**—Do you like number games? Are logic problems fun? Are you most comfortable working in a logical, orderly manner? Do you tend to consider questions in a one, two, three sequence rather than skipping around?

___ **EYS**—Do you like to watch movies, television? Do you enjoy museums? Do you usually draw pictures to help you see how things look or to help you understand a concept?

___ **EAS**—Do you remember what you hear? Do you like to listen to music? Do you enjoy playing a musical instrument? Do you belong to a choir?

___ **BS**—Do you enjoy working with your hands, manipulating objects? Is it fun to work on your car, repair the toaster, knit, or crochet?

___ **PS**—Do you like to talk things over with others? Do you have fun exploring ideas in a group? Do you shine in group discussions?

___ **SS**—Do you like to think over ideas inside your head? Do you prefer to be alone to consider problems, challenges?

___ **NS**—Do you like to classify objects, people, events, and/or group things into lists?
