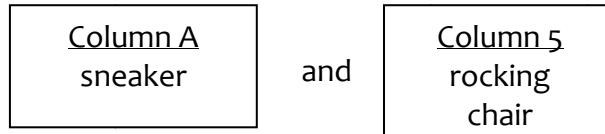


Differences

Example: **Possibilities** words

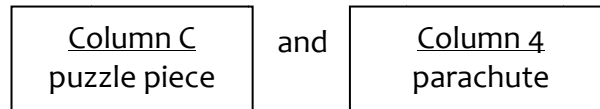


A sneaker is not like a rocking chair because you go through more different sizes of sneakers in your life than the number of different sizes of rocking chairs.
