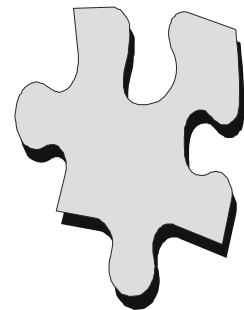
1. Do test-prep curricula help students learn broad content and skills, get higher test scores, or both? What are the advantages and disadvantages of this type of curriculum?
